Reading Answers

1. A. Calling the congregation and for breaking camp (2 to Call the congregation for meeting at the Tent of Meeting – 1 To Call Leaders – Blowing and Shouting for Departing) (Numbers 10:2-7)

B. Going into battle for being remembered before **יהוה** (Numbers 10:9)

C. Days of Gladness, Appointed Times, and Beginning of Months (Numbers 10:10)

D. Burnt Offerings & Peace Offerings (for remembrance before Elohiym) (Numbers 10:10)

2. The Sons of Aharon (Numbers 10:8)
3. Twentieth day of the second month, in the second year (Numbers 10:11)
4. Three days (Numbers 10:33)
5. Seeking out a resting place (Numbers 10:33)
6. 20th, 21st, 22nd
7. On the 20th, 21st, and 22nd of the 2nd month they were not resting – they were on a journey seeking out a resting place. This is the biggest evidence, in my opinion, that the 7th Day Sabbath is a continual 7 day cycle and not a cycle that restarts every month based upon the new moon (otherwise known as “Lunar Sabbath”). I do not see how Lunar Sabbath doctrines are possibly correct because they were on a journey on both the 21st and the 22nd.
8. 1st - Yehudah, Yissaskhar, Zevulun
2nd - The sons of Gershon and the sons of Merari with the Dwelling Place
3rd - Re'uven, Shim'on, Gad
4th - The Qehathites with the set-apart objects
5th – Ephrayim, Menashsheh, Binyamin
6th – Dan, Asher, Naphtali
(Numbers 10:14-28)
9. When the people were as complainers (Numbers 11:1)
10. Weeping and saying “Why did we come up out of Mitsrayim?” (Numbers 11:20)
11. Man (אִישׁ)
12. Approximately 3 feet (2 Cubits – Numbers 11:31)
13. Lusting after meat (Numbers 11:31-34)
14. He makes Himself known in a vision and speaks to him in a dream
(Numbers 12:6)
15. We don't want to hold grudges against people – we want to cry out to יהוה for them. (Numbers 12:13)
16. They were not believing in יהוה bringing them into the land but were talking about appointing a leader to go back to Mitsrayim (Egypt). (Numbers 14:1-10)

17. “How long shall I be scorned by these people? And how long shall I not be trusted by them, with all the signs which I have done in their midst?”

What we can learn from this is that we need to just trust in **יהוה** and remember all of the things **יהוה** has shown us. Trusting in **יהוה** is very crucial and it is important to **יהוה** that we trust in Him. (Numbers 14:11)

18. They died by the plague before **יהוה**. What we learn from this is that those who have speaking roles in the assembly do not want to do anything that will cause others to grumble. It is a serious thing to cause the assembly to sin. (Numbers 14:36-38)
